Mission Statement:

Provide short-term financial and other emergency assistance to individuals and families with short-term needs.

Objective(s):

- 1) Make food, clothing and other resources available to individuals and families in need on a case-by-case basis
- 2) Focus a portion of our benevolent assistance on those individuals and families who are willing to be instructed in the word of God
- 3) Focus a portion of our benevolent assistance on individuals who are willing to strengthen skills necessary for self-support
- 4) Use benevolent assistance as a stepping stone to lasting change in the lives of the recipients

Opportunities To Serve:

- 01 Mentor an individual who is willing to pursue self-improvement
- 02 Identify cases where our benevolent assistance will lead to life-changing results
- 03 Provide a link between those seeking employment and businesses which may be seeking employees

BUILDING MAINTENANCE

Terry Turner

Mission Statement:

Maintain our church building in top working condition and seek ways to improve it in both operation and appearance.

Objective(s):

- 1) Keep our church building in proper working order
- 2) Make repairs as they become necessary; seek professionals if required
- 3) Maintain aesthetics of building
- 4) Work with janitorial employee to ensure the building is clean and ready to use
- 5) Organize individual involvement for periodic workdays and/or significant projects

Opportunities To Serve:

- 01 Change light bulbs and ballasts as needed throughout the building
- 02 Repair plumbing to any restroom, kitchen, or plumbed area
- 03 Maintain baptistery by keeping the water at proper levels, ensuring proper temperature, draining and cleaning it, and replacing the filter
- 04 Keep building painted as it becomes needed
- 05 Monitor thermostats throughout building
- 06 Replace filters in all air handling equipment
- 07 Maintain kitchen equipment
- 08 Order any furniture (chairs and tables) as necessary
- 09 Clean carpet as required using professionals as required

BULLETIN BOARDS

Mission Statement:

Organize each bulletin board so members or visitors can observe the different activities that are happening, the type of mission works we support, and inspirational messages.

Objective(s):

- 1) Provide inspirational messages to members and visitors
- 2) Provide information about what is going on at church or area churches of Christ
- 3) Provide information on missionaries that we support and about the work they do
- 4) Know your family through "Our Church Family Album" in foyer

Opportunities To Serve:

- 01 Be a coordinator
 - A. Will organize and maintain a rotation chart for each board that will rotate volunteers through the year.
 - B. Will provide volunteers with the rotation schedule

- 02 Be a volunteer
 - A. Works under the coordinator
 - B. Make sure the board she/he is in charge of is changed within the month she/he is assigned
 - C. Each board will be changed seasonally: Summer, Spring, Winter, and Fall. The change-out months will be December, March, June, and September.

Mission Statement:

Provide effective Bible-centered classes for all ages that inspire both members and visitors to engage in more personal study of God's Word. Across the age groups of our Bible students, we will strive to:

- Provide lessons for children that will create lasting memories of Bible characters and Christian principles and a desire to serve God and continue learning.

- 4) Provide Bible class materials including curriculum, bulletin boards, visual aids, idea books, and other resources in an effective and organized manner through the Teachers Workroom
- 5) Provide assistance to teachers that will enable them to be more effective in presenting Bible lessons to our students. This assistance will come through areas such as Teachers Workshops and services to assist them in the creation of class materials.
- 6) Establish a group of people who can serve the Ashville Road Bible classes outside of the classroom by developing class materials for teachers, such as bulletin boards and visual aids

SECURITY

Mission Statement:

Provide security surveillance of parking lot while worship services and Bible studies are in progress. Provide assistance and guidance to visitors, helping them get to the desired classes, and/or worship service.

Objective(s):

This will be accomplished through an expanded definition of the duties of ushers.

- 1) One usher will arrive 20 to 30 minutes early to open the building, verifying all utilities are functioning and the building is ready for use. A second usher will stay 30 to 45 minutes after services to close, lock, and secure the building until the next service.
- 2) Ushers will be responsible for periodically checking that the parking lots are safe and secure during Bible study and worship services. They are to assist anyone arriving late to class or worship when needed. This task will be done partly through security cameras throughout the building.
- 3) Ushers will also assist in serving the Lord's Supper to the attendants and any mothers in the nursery, and then carry the trays to the kitchen for later cleanup

SENIORS SERVING CHRIST

We believe that statement sums up how we approach ministries at Ashville Road. Ministering or serving is to be done with the attitude that we find in the life of our example, Jesus Christ, who stated that He "did not come to be served, but to serve." Matthew 20:28

At Ashville Road our seniors "still bear much fruit" (Psalms 92:12-15) in many areas including faith, hope, love, patience, gratitude, wisdom, service, contentment and helpfulness in the Lord. Their maturity in these areas is a great blessing as they fulfill their role as mentors.

Mission Statement:

Provide spiritual strength and build closer relationships among our senior adult members.

Objective(s):

- 1) Provide the opportunity for Seniors to work together to help others
- 2) Provide a time and place for Seniors to get together for a monthly meal of fellowship and fun (Nifty Fifties)
- 3) Provide the opportunity for visitation of the sick, and benevolent assistance to members with special needs
- 4) Provide the opportunity for **Seniors Serving Christ** to attend singings together at different congregations
- 5) Areas where we can participate

Household: Involves cleaning, washing, ironing, etc. for those recovering from illness

Shopping: Requires doing necessary errands such as going to the cleaners, banking, general shopping

Sitting: Sitting with those who are sick, at home or hospital

Yard Work: Outside work that is needed around the home

Repairs: General repairs in and around the home.

Spiritual: Devotional for those who are ill

Other: Help families with funerals, provide snacks for families with loved ones in care units at hospitals

Opportunities To Serve:

- 01 Be a driver for the **Seniors Serving Christ** events when needed, coordinating with the transportation deacon
- 02 Help with household duties while someone is recovering from illness
- 03 Doing necessary errands for anyone with special needs
- 04 Sitting with someone with needs at home or in the hospital
- 05 Helping with yard work for someone who is unable to perform it
- 06 Help with home repairs for someone who is unable to perform them
- 07 Help with funerals, meals, singing or other needs
- 08 Take snacks and fruit to hospitals
